TERMS AND CONDITIONS

COST - Maritime Welding Program cost: Non-Refundable Registration fee - \$100.00, Tuition - \$13,400, Estimated equipment/supplies - \$1094.00, Lab Fee - \$800.00, Physical - \$75.00 and Campus Parking Permit - \$160.00.

CREDENTIALS – Upon successful completion of this course a student will be awarded a Maritime Welding diploma, an American Welding Society (AWS) Certificate of Completion - Certified AWS Entry Level Welder, AWS Entry Level Welder Certification Card, name added to nationally searchable AWS database, through the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) students will receive certification in Core, as a Basic Rigger, Level I and Level II Entry Level Welding, all credentials will be added to the national NCCER registry.

SCHOOLS RESPONSIBILITY – CDA Technical Institute (CDA) agrees to make available to the applicant classroom space, all welding equipment and supplies (other than personal welding gear required to be furnished by the student as outlined in the CDA catalog), welding station space, handouts and instruction in the course outline in the program designated for the period indicated. CDA agrees to award the appropriate diploma and certificates and to provide assistance in locating employment as outlined in the CDA catalog after the student meets all requirements for the course completion. CDA reserves the right to schedule subjects within the curriculum in the order deemed necessary and, if necessary, to change or revise class starting dates. Reasonable and appropriate substitutions in curriculum may be made by CDA as deemed necessary.

STUDENT PLACEMENT – Students are assisted with placement and furnished names and addresses of employment possibilities. CDA will assist the student with employment to the best of its ability, but cannot guarantee employment.

METHOD AND TERMS OF PAYMENT - CDA has three payment plans available to the students attending the Maritime Welding Program, please choose from one of the following:

1. ___ All charges are paid in full three (3) weeks prior to the start of class using one of our approved payment methods.
2. ___ All charges are paid in two installments: 50% six weeks before start date and the remaining 50% due the eighth week of school. (Plan 1 covers financial aid and student loans.)
3. ___ All charges paid in four installments: \$7,000 due six weeks before start date, remaining balance due fourth week, eighth week, and twelfth week of the classes in three installments.

Late payment fee of \$25.00 is charged for all late payments, not exceeding \$75.00 total per term.

STUDENT PERFORMANCE – The student agrees to attend classes regularly, study diligently, and abide by the rules and regulations of CDA. It is understood that failure by the student to attend class regularly, study diligently, or to abide by the rules and regulations of CDA, as stated in its catalog, or as otherwise prescribed by CDA, now or in the future, verbally or in written form, may result in immediate suspension or termination at the option of CDA and CDA will not be held responsible for the remaining portion of the course of instruction. It is understood that such rules and regulations to be imposed in the future will be reasonable and proper.

REFUNDS - Cancellation must be made in person or by certified mail. All money will be refunded if the applicant is not accepted by the school or if the student cancels within three (3) business days after the enrollment agreement and making initial payment. Cancellation after the third (3rd) business day, but before the first day of class, will result in a refund of all money paid, with the exception of the registration fee. Cancellation after attendance has begun, but prior to 50% completion of the program, will result in a prorated refund computed on the number of hours completed to the total program hours. Cancellation after completing 50% of the program will result in no refund.

TERMINATION DATE - The termination date for refund computation purposes is the last date of actual attendance by the student unless earlier written notice is received. Refunds will be made within 30 days of termination or receipt of cancellation notice.

WITHDRAWAL – The withdrawal process is initiated in the Registrar’s Office. Students who are absent from the program for two consecutive weeks will be automatically withdrawn from the program, and will be refunded according to the refund policy, unless prior arrangements have been made with the administration. The student may withdraw from CDA at anytime and the official date of withdrawal (for all purposes, including computing tuition refunds) shall be considered to have occurred on the last day of actual attendance regardless of whether any written notice is received by CDA.

TRANSCRIPTS – CDA is authorized to request copies of the applicant’s high school, trade school and college transcripts, if applicable.

AGREEMENT – Both pages of the Enrollment Agreement constitutes one agreement. This agreement shall not be binding until it is accepted in writing by the school. Upon acceptance by CDA Technical Institute, this Enrollment Agreement becomes an agreement whereby the following terms and conditions are understood and agreed to by CDA and each party signing this Agreement.

ARBITRATION AGREEMENT - Any dispute arising from enrollment at CDA, no matter how described, pleaded or styled, shall be resolved by binding arbitration by a single arbitrator under the Federal Arbitration Act conducted by the American Arbitration Association (“AAA”) at Jacksonville, Florida, under its Commercial Rules. All determinations as to the scope, enforceability of this Arbitration Agreement shall be determined by the Arbitrator, and not by a court. The award rendered by the arbitrator may be entered in any court having jurisdiction.
